OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY

HONOLULU – Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) work furlough inmate Samuel Campbell failed to return to Module 20 last night. He was supposed to return by 8:30 p.m. Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

Campbell is 38-years old. He is 5'11" tall and weighs 247 lbs. He has brown hair and brown eyes.

Campbell is serving time for Unauthorized Entry into a Motor Vehicle 1. His next parole hearing is scheduled for July of this year. He now faces an additional escape charge when found.

He is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
