**MISSING OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE TURNS HIMSELF IN AT OCCC**

HONOLULU – Missing work furlough inmate Lyle Botelho voluntarily turned himself in at about 7:10 a.m. at the Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC). Sheriffs will process him on an escape charge. Botelho failed to return after work to OCCC Module 20 on September 25th.

Botelho is serving time for Methamphetamine Trafficking 2. His next parole hearing was scheduled for January. He is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
