SHERIFF DIVISION STATS: WARRANTS CLEARED/FUGITIVE ARRESTS MADE

HONOLULU – During the month of January 2018, the Sheriff Division Special Operations Section Fugitive Unit arrested ___ offenders and cleared 150 total warrants.

The warrants included 41 Felony Grand Jury Indictments, 13 Parole Violators, 19 Probation Violators, 27 Criminal Warrants, and 44 Traffic Warrants.

The Sheriff Division Special Operations Section Fugitive Unit works tirelessly each day to track, locate, and apprehend wanted felons and fugitives while also providing vital law enforcement services such as K9 explosive detection, tactical response to critical incidents to State and County Agencies on every island, as well as transport services for high-risk prisoners.
