SHERIFFS ARREST MISSING OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE

HONOLULU – Sheriffs with the Special Operations Fugitive Unit arrested missing Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) work furlough inmate Bryce Takara. They convinced Takara to voluntarily turn himself. He was taken into custody at 9:05 a.m. and transported to the Sheriff booking station for processing. He will be returned to OCCC on a new Escape 2 charge. On February 8, Takahara failed to return to Module 20 after work.

Takara is serving time for Burglary 1 and Kidnapping. His next parole hearing is scheduled for April of this year.

Takara is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
