## SHERIFFS CAPTURE CRIMESTOPPERS FUGITIVE

HONOLULU – Sheriffs with the Special Operations Fugitive Unit arrested wanted fugitive Jacob Hoopai. Acting on a tip, Sheriff Deputies located Hoopai in a vehicle in the Haleiwa area at approximately 8 a.m. A 29-year-old female passenger, Kalehuaiwiliiamekamaile "Maile" Montez, was also arrested on outstanding warrants and for hindering prosecution.

CrimeStoppers and the Honolulu Police Department put out a bulletin on December 14<sup>th</sup> seeking public assistance in locating Hoopai. He was wanted for a Hawaii Paroling Authority No Bail Warrant for violating the terms and conditions of parole. Hoopai was serving time for Burglary 1. He will be seen by the parole board within the next 60 days.
