### STATE SHERIFFS ARREST MISSING WCCC FURLOUGH INMATE

HONOLULU – Sheriffs with the Special Operations Fugitive Unit arrested missing Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) inmate Kawaihani Awana. She was located and arrested in the Kalihi area at about 10:30 a.m. On May 4, 2017, Awana failed to return back to the facility from her furlough pass. Once processed, Sheriffs will return her to WCCC custody.

Awana is serving time for Methamphetamine Trafficking 2. Escape 2 is expected to be added to her charges. She was a community custody inmate with furlough pass privileges. Community Custody is the lowest custody level.
