### STATE SHERIFFS ARREST MISSING WCCC EXTENDED FURLOUGH INMATE

HONOLULU – Sheriffs with the Special Operations Fugitive Unit arrested missing Women’s Community Correctional Center (WCCC) extended furlough inmate Hiipoi Lopez. She was located and arrested in the Kunia area at about 11 a.m. Once processed, Sheriffs will return her to WCCC custody.

On April 10, Lopez was reported missing from the YWCA Fernhurst work furlough home where she was residing. Inmates in the extended furlough program live and work outside of the prison facility.

Lopez is serving time for Promotion a Dangerous Drug 2. Her next parole hearing is scheduled for June 2018. Escape 2 is expected to be added to her charges. Lopez was a community custody inmate with furlough pass privileges. Community Custody is the lowest custody level.
