WCCC INMATE FAILS TO RETURN FROM WORK FURLOUGH PASS

HONOLULU – Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) inmate Pikake Watson failed to return to the facility after work. She was scheduled to return at 9:30 p.m. last night. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified of her failure to return.

Watson is 36-years old, 4'11" tall and weighs 136 lbs. She has brown hair and brown eyes. She has a tattoo across her chest that says "Briggs" and a smaller tattoo across the right side of her neck.

She is serving time for ID Theft 2. Escape 2 is expected to be added to her charges. Her next parole hearing is scheduled for June of this year.

Watson is a community custody inmate with furlough pass privileges. Community Custody is the lowest custody level.
