**WOMENS COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTER FURLOUGH INMATE  
FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY**

HONOLULU – Furlough inmate Wendy Canon failed to return to the Women’s Community Correctional Center last night. She was scheduled to return by 9 p.m. Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

61-year old Canon is 5’7” and weighs 126 lbs. She has salt and pepper hair and brown eyes.

Canon is serving time for Promotion of a Dangerous Drug 2. Her next parole hearing was scheduled for February 2019. She now faces an additional escape charge when found.

Canon is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
