WOMEN'S COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTER FURLOUGH INMATE ASHLEY AKANA FAILED TO RETURN

Work furlough inmate Ashley Akana failed to return to WCCC furlough housing unit tonight. She was supposed to return by 9:30 pm. Sheriffs and HPD were notified.

Akana is 34 years old, 5'4" tall, and 210 lbs. She has brown hair and brown eyes.

Akana is serving time for Burglary 1st, multiple Theft offenses, Forgery of Credit Cards, Promoting Dangerous Drugs 3rd. Her minimum sentence will expire on 11/2/2019. She now faces an additional escape charge when found.

She is a community custody inmate in the furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
