

Department of Public Safety COVID-19 Update for 11/25/20:

Mass Inmate Testing Continues

There were two (2) more **negative** inmate test results received as part of the mass testing efforts at the Waiawa Correctional Facility. The total positive remains unchanged at 149 with one (1) inmate in the hospital. The rest of the facility has been placed in quarantine and offenders are being retested as part of the surge testing effort. The total number of staff who have confirmed positive cases is ten (10). DOH is conducting contact tracing. All WCF staff are in full PPE and the warden previously halted all inmate movement last Wednesday to prevent further transmission within the facility and to the other facilities.

DOH testing of O'ahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) inmates and staff is continuous. Of the 147 OCCC inmate test results received, four (4) were positive and 143 were negative. There are no OCCC inmates in the hospital. For more information on PSD's planning and response efforts to COVID-19:
