

Department of Public Safety COVID-19 Update for 2/10/21:
Statewide Inmate Testing Continues

The Maui Community Correctional Center (MCCC) reports 38 inmate test results as part of mass testing efforts underway at the facility. Of that number, four (4) were positive and 34 were negative. The total positive inmate cases is at 12. No MCCC staff have reported having COVID-19.

COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. Halawa Correctional Facility (HCF) reports one (1) positive staff result and one (1) staff recovery. HCF also reports that the remaining three (3) inmate cases have been medically cleared as no longer active COVID-19 cases. That means Halawa is now clear of all active inmate cases. The Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) reports one (1) positive staff result. There were 29 negative OCCC inmate test results received.
