

Department of Public Safety COVID-19 Update for 2/11/21:
Statewide Inmate Testing Continues

The Maui Community Correctional Center (MCCC) reports 49 inmate test results as part of mass testing efforts underway at the facility. Of that number, eight (8) were positive, 40 were negative and one (1) was inconclusive. The total positive inmate cases are at 20. There were 17 negative MCCC staff results also received. No MCCC staff have reported having COVID-19.

COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. Halawa Correctional Facility (HCF) reports one (1) negative inmate test result, and three (3) negative staff results. HCF is clear of all active inmate cases. The O'ahu Community Correctional Center reports 83 test results, 82 of which were negative and one (1) was inconclusive.
