

Department of Public Safety COVID-19 Update for 2/4/21:

Second MCCC Inmate Positive for COVID-19, Statewide Inmate Testing Continues

The Maui Community Correctional Center (MCCC) reports 1 (one) new positive inmate case bringing the current total to two (2) positive cases at the facility. There are 21 inmates in medical isolation and 75 inmates on quarantine status as they undergo precautionary testing. There are two (2) adult corrections officers on a precautionary 14-day quarantine due to possible exposure. Both were advised to get tested and to see their private personal care providers for further evaluation if needed. No MCCC staff have reported having COVID-19. MCCC is working collaboratively with the Maui District Health Office, the Department of Health and the Hawaii Army National Guard to implement mass testing of affected inmates and staff.

SARS-CoV-2 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. The Halawa Correctional Facility reported 3 negative staff test results.
