

**Department of Public Safety COVID-19 Update for 2/9/21:**  
**Statewide Inmate Testing Continues**

The Maui Community Correctional Center (MCCC) reports 22 inmate test results as part of mass testing efforts underway at the facility. Of that number, 21 were negative and one (1) was inconclusive. The total positive inmate cases remain unchanged at eight (8). There are 23 inmates in medical isolation, including the eight (8) confirmed positive cases, and an additional 83 inmates on quarantine status. No MCCC staff have reported having COVID-19. COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities.
