2 WCCC Staff Positive, Statewide Inmate Testing Continues

COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. Two (2) Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) employees have reported positive test results to the facility. The employees last worked March 23, 2021. No WCCC inmates have reported symptoms but as a precaution the facility has enacted their pandemic protocol to quarantine the facility and suspend all inmate movement. The Department of Health has initiated contact tracing. WCCC is coordinating mass testing with the assistance of the Hawaii National Guard. The facility staff sanitized the spaces where the employees worked.

The Maui Community Correctional Center (MCCC) reports one (1) negative inmate test result. The active positive inmate total remains unchanged at three (3). The one (1) hospitalized MCCC inmate returned to the facility today. The Oahu Community Correctional center reports 47 negative inmate test result.
