

Department of Public Safety COVID-19 Update for 3/29/21

Statewide Inmate Testing Continues

COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. The Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) reports one (1) negative inmate result. As a result of the two (2) employees who reported positive results last week, the facility enacted their pandemic protocol to quarantine the facility and suspend all inmate movement. No WCCC inmates have reported symptoms. The Department of Health is contact tracing and WCCC is coordinating mass testing with the assistance of the Hawaii National Guard.

The Maui Community Correctional Center (MCCC) reports 39 inmate results. Of that number, five (5) were positive and 34 were negative. There are no MCCC inmates in the hospital. There was also 10 negative staff results reported. The Oahu Community Correctional center reports 28 negative inmate test result.
