Inmate Testing Continues Statewide

COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. There are currently no confirmed active COVID-19 cases in the inmate population. The two (2) Maui Community Correctional Center (MCCC) staff who have been out due to COVID have recovered and returned to work. The facility is clear of all COVID cases. MCCC reports an additional 12 negative inmate test results.

The rest of the negative inmate test results received for other correctional facilities are as follows:

Oʻahu Community Correctional Center - 34 negative inmate test results Halawa Correctional Facility – 18 negative inmate test results Hawaii Community Correctional Center – 13 negative inmate test results Waiawa Correctional Facility – 5 negative inmate test results. Women's Community Correctional Center – 2 negative inmate test results Kulani Correctional Facility – 1 negative inmate test result
