Department of Public Safety COVID-19 Update for 5/13/21

2 Employees in Training Section COVID-19 Positive, Inmate Testing Continues Statewide

Two (2) Department of Public Safety (PSD) employees currently assigned to the Training and Staff Development (TSD) section have confirmed positive COVID-19 test results. This brings the total since yesterday's report to four (4) positive employee cases at the training building. The Department of Health (DOH) is conducting contact tracing. Testing begins tomorrow for TSD employees.

COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. There are currently no confirmed active COVID-19 cases in the inmate population. The Maui Community Correctional Center reports 33 negative inmate test results and 14 negative staff results.

The rest of the inmate test results received are as follows: Oahu Community Correctional Center - 26 negative inmate test results Women's Community Correctional Center – 1 negative inmate test results Halawa Correctional Facility – 1 negative inmate test results
