Department of Public Safety COVID-19 Update for 5/27/21

1 HCCC Inmate Positive, HCF and OCCC Clear of COVID

The Hawaii Community Correctional Center (HCCC) reports one positive inmate test result. The total positive inmate cases stand at seven. The Halawa Correctional Facility (HCF) and Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) are both clear of all COVID-19 cases. The one previously reported positive inmate at HCF and the two inmates at OCCC have all been medically cleared as recovered. OCCC also reports 11 negative inmate test results.

COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. The test results received at other facilities are as follows:

Women's Community Correctional Center – 6 negative inmate test results Maui Community Correctional Center – 2 negative inmate test results, 20 negative staff test results.

The Department of Public Safety (PSD) continues to encourage all staff and inmates to voluntarily receive the COVID vaccination.
