DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY COVID-19 UPDATE

HONOLULU – The Department of Public Safety is clear of all active COVID-19 cases. COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted in the state prisons and jails as well as in the contracted Saguaro Correctional Center in Eloy, AZ. The latest testing updates received for other correctional facilities are as follows:

Oahu Community Correctional Center – 44 negative inmate results.

Kauai Community Correctional Center – 5 negative inmate test results. One (1) employee who was previously reported as positive has recovered. The facility is clear of all active COVID-19 cases.

Waiawa Correctional Facility – One (1) negative inmate test result and two (2) negative staff test results.
