DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY COVID-19 UPDATE

HONOLULU – The Hawaii Community Correctional Center (HCCC) reports six staff test results received, of which, one was positive and five were negative. There were 14 negative inmate test results received. The active positive inmate cases remain unchanged at five. There are no inmates in the hospital.

COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. The latest testing updates received for other facilities are as follows:

Waiawa Correctional Facility – 4 negative **staff** test results. Oahu Community Correctional Center – 36 negative inmate test results Halawa Correctional Facility – 4 negative inmate test results. Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) – 3 negative inmate test results

The Department of Public Safety (PSD) continues to encourage all staff and inmates to voluntarily get tested and receive the COVID vaccination.
