## DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY COVID-19 UPDATE

HONOLULU – The Hawaii Community Correctional Center (HCCC) reports one positive staff test result. There were no new inmate test results received. The active positive inmate cases remain unchanged at five. The Oahu Community Correctional Center reports one positive employee case. The previously reported active inmate case at OCCC has been cleared as recovered. The inmate population at OCCC is clear of all active COVID-19 cases. In addition, there were 44 negative inmate test results received for OCCC.

COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. The latest testing updates received for other facilities are as follows:

Halawa Correctional Facility – 7 negative inmate test results. Women's Community Correctional Center – 1 negative inmate test result.

The Department of Public Safety (PSD) continues to encourage all staff and inmates to voluntarily get tested and receive the COVID vaccination.
