DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY COVID-19 UPDATE

HONOLULU – COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. The latest testing updates received for the correctional facilities are as follows:

Maui Community Correctional Center – 58 inmate test results: 21 positive, 37 negative Halawa Correctional Facility – 16 inmate test results: 1 positive, 15 negative Hawaii Community Correctional Center – 1 positive staff test result, 2 negative inmate test results

The Department of Public Safety (PSD) continues to encourage all staff and inmates to voluntarily get tested and receive the COVID vaccination.
