DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY COVID-19 UPDATE

HONOLULU – COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted in the state prisons and jails as well as in the contracted Saguaro Correctional Center in Eloy, AZ. The Department of Public Safety (PSD) continues to encourage all staff and inmates to voluntarily get tested and receive the COVID-19 vaccination. The latest testing updates received for the correctional facilities are as follows:

Maui Community Correctional Center – 121 inmate test results: Six (6) positive, 115 negative **Oahu Community Correctional Center** – 10 positive inmate test results.

Halawa Correctional Facility – One (1) positive staff test result received. No new inmate test results received.

Kauai Community Correctional Center – One (1) inmate recovered increasing the total recoveries to 45. No new test results received.
