HONOLULU – COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. The Halawa Correctional Facility reports two positive staff results.

The latest testing updates received are as follows:

Women's Community Correctional Center – 6 negative inmate test results

Maui Community Correctional Center – 2 negative inmate test results

Kauai Community Correctional Center – 1 negative inmate test result
