DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY COVID-19 UPDATE

HONOLULU – COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted in the state prisons and jails as well as in the contracted Saguaro Correctional Center in Eloy, AZ. The latest testing updates received for other correctional facilities are as follows:

Oahu Community Correctional Center – 122 inmate test results: Two (2) positive, 120 negative. Three (3) OCCC employee have recovered and returned to work, dropping the total active positive staff cases to eight (8).

Hawaii Community Correctional Center – Four (4) negative inmate test results. There was also one (1) negative staff test result reported and one (1) staff recovery. All HCCC staff are clear of COVID-19.

Maui Community Correctional Center – One (1) negative inmate test result. **Halawa Correctional Facility** – One (1) negative inmate test result.

Women's Community Correctional Center – One (1) employee has recovered and was cleared to return to work, dropping the total active positive staff cases to one (1).

Also, one (1) Administrative Division employee previously reported positive has recovered and is cleared to return to work. That leaves just three (3) active positive Admin. Division employee cases.

The Department of Public Safety (PSD) continues to encourage all staff and inmates to voluntarily get tested and receive the COVID-19 vaccination.
