**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY STAFF TRAINING CENTER TEMPORARILY
SUSPENDS CORRECTIONS TRAINING AFTER 2 EMPLOYEES CONFIRM
POSITIVE COVID-19 RESULTS**

HONOLULU – Two (2) Department of Public Safety (PSD) employees currently assigned to the Training and Staff Development (TSD) section have confirmed positive COVID-19 test results. The Department of Health (DOH) is conducting contact tracing. Testing is being scheduled for TSD employees. As a precaution, all corrections training-related activities are suspended for 10 days. A corrections recruit class graduation planned for Friday is also being postponed until PSD is given the medical all-clear.
