CDC will host a webinar for healthcare providers on Thursday, March 5 to help you learn what you can do to prepare for COVID-19 including:

- identifying persons under investigation,
- applying infection prevention and control measures,
- assessing risks of exposures,
- optimizing the use of personal protective equipment supplies

and managing and caring for patients.

The CDC continues its investigation of the coronavirus. As of March 2, the CDC has reported cases in 10 states.
