### **DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY COVID-19 UPDATE**

HONOLULU – COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. The latest testing updates received for other facilities are as follows:

Oahu Community Correctional Center – 24 negative inmate test results  
Maui Community Correctional Center – 85 negative inmate test results  
Women’s Community Correctional Center – 2 negative inmate test results  
Halawa Correctional Facility – 2 negative inmate test results

The Department of Public Safety (PSD) continues to encourage all staff and inmates to voluntarily get tested and receive the COVID vaccination.
