DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY COVID-19 UPDATE

HONOLULU – COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. Maui Community Correctional Center (MCCC) reports six new positive staff cases. Waiawa Correctional Facility (WCF) reports two new positive staff cases. The Hawaii Community Correctional Center (HCCC) reports 54 inmate test results, three of which was positive and 51 were negative. The Maui Community Correctional Center (MCCC) reports seven inmate test results, two of which were positive and five were negative. The facility health care staff and the Department of Health have initiated contact tracing and are coordinating voluntary testing for inmates.

The latest testing updates received for facilities are as follows: Oahu Community Correctional Center – 1 negative inmate test results Kauai Community Correctional Center – 1 negative inmate test results

The Department of Public Safety (PSD) continues to encourage all staff and inmates to voluntarily get tested and receive the COVID vaccination.
