## DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY COVID-19 UPDATE

HONOLULU – COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. Halawa Correctional Facility (HCF) reports 196 inmate test results with 26 positive results and 170 negative results. HCF reports six negative staff results. Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) reports 25 inmate test result with two positive results and 23 negative results. The facility health care staff and the Department of Health have initiated contact tracing and are coordinating voluntary testing for inmates.

The latest testing updates received for other facilities are as follows: Hawaii Community Correctional Center – 2 negative inmate test results Maui Community Correctional Center – 47 negative inmate test results

The Department of Public Safety (PSD) continues to encourage all staff and inmates to voluntarily get tested and receive the COVID vaccination.
