HONOLULU – COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted in the state prisons and jails. The latest testing updates received for the correctional facilities are as follows:

Oahu Community Correctional Center – One (1) negative inmate test result.
Kauai Community Correctional Center – One (1) negative inmate test result.
Hawaii Community Correctional Center – One (1) negative inmate test.
Women’s Community Correctional Center – 46 negative inmate test results.

The Department of Public Safety (PSD) continues to encourage all staff and inmates to voluntarily get tested and receive the COVID-19 vaccination.
