DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY COVID-19 UPDATE

HONOLULU – COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted in the state prisons and jails as well as in the contracted Saguro Correctional Center in Eloy, AZ. The latest testing updates received for the correctional facilities are as follows:

Kauai Community Correctional Center – 28 inmate test results; 13 positive, 15 negative.
Women's Community Correctional Center – 23 inmate test results; Eight (8) positive, 15 negative.
Hawaii Community Correctional Center – 10 inmate test results; 10 negative.
Oahu Community Correctional Center – 112 inmate test results; 14 positive, 98 negative. Two (2) staff have recovered.
Halawa Correctional Facility – 194 inmate test results; 60 positive, 134 negative. Two (2) positive employee test results were received. One (1) employee has recovered.
Waiawa Correctional Facility – 36 inmate test results; 36 negative.
Saguro Correctional Center – 273 inmate test results, 27 positive, 246 negative.

COVID-19 updates for other PSD Divisions are as follows:

Administration – One (1) positive staff test result reported.

The Department of Public Safety (PSD) continues to encourage all staff and inmates to voluntarily get tested and receive the COVID-19 vaccination.
