## WORK FURLOUGH INMATE MAKES UNAUTHORIZED EXIT FROM THE LAUMAKA WORK FURLOUGH CENTER

HONOLULU – Work furlough inmate Robert Yamaguchi left the Laumaka Work Furlough Center at about 3:30 p.m. He was not authorized to leave. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified of the unauthorized exit.

Yamaguchi is 34-years old. He is 5'3" tall and weighs 162 lbs. He has brown eyes and brown hair but shaves his head. He has the name "Melissa" tattooed on the right side of his neck.

Yamaguchi is serving time for Unauthorized Control of a Propelled Vehicle, Promoting a Dangerous Drug, Unlawful Use of Drug Paraphernalia and Bail Jumping. His next parole hearing is scheduled for August of this year. He faces an additional escape charge when found.

Yamaguchi is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
