MISSING MCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE RETURNED TO FACILITY. WCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE STILL MISSING

Missing Maui Community Correctional Center (MCCC) work furlough inmate Gregory Anthony was arrested by Maui Police today and returned to MCCC at about 2:15 p.m. On April 29th, he failed to return from work at his scheduled return time of 7 p.m.

He is serving time for Theft 2, Credit Card Theft, Credit Card Fraud, Burglary 1, and Unauthorized Control of a Propelled Vehicle. His parole hearing was scheduled for July 2020. He now faces a new escape charge.

Work furlough inmate Ashley Soares is still missing. She failed to return to the Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) furlough housing unit on April 29th. She was supposed to return by 9 p.m.

Soares is 36 years old, 5'6" tall, and 200 lbs. She has brown hair and brown eyes. She is serving time for Methamphetamine Trafficking 2 and Promoting a Dangerous Drug 3. Her next parole hearing is scheduled for October of this

year.

Soares and Anthony are community custody inmates in the furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
