OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY

HONOLULU – Laumaka work furlough inmate Tyler Adams failed to return to the Laumaka Work Furlough Center. He was supposed to return by 6 p.m. Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

47-year-old Adams is 5'9" and weighs 168 lbs. He has a brown hair and blue eyes.

Adams is serving time for Theft 1 and 2. His next parole hearing is scheduled for September. He now faces an additional escape charge when found.

He is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
