HONOLULU – Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) work furlough inmate Daniel Vierra failed to return from his furlough pass to OCCC Module 20. He was supposed to return by 8 p.m. Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

50 year-old Vierra is 5'6" and weighs 159 lbs. He has brown eyes and hair.

Vierra is serving time for Theft 2, Criminal Property Damage 1, Terroristic Threatening 1, and Unauthorized Control of a Propelled Vehicle. His next parole hearing was scheduled for November of this year. He now faces an additional escape charge when found.

Vierra is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
