OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO FACILITY

HONOLULU – Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) work furlough inmate Kevin Mercado-Nardo failed to return from his furlough pass to OCCC Module 20. He was supposed to return by 8 p.m. Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified.

29-year-old Mercado-Nardo is 6'3" and weighs 209 lbs. He has brown eyes and brown hair.

Mercado-Nardo is serving time for Burglary 1 and Robbery 2. His next parole hearing was scheduled for August 2020. He now faces an additional escape charge when found.

Mercado-Nardo is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
