OCCC WORK FURLOUGH INMATE RETURNS LATE TO FACILITY

HONOLULU – Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) work furlough inmate Jtery Stephen showed up late to OCCC Module 20 after work. He was supposed to return by 5 p.m. but returned shortly before 7 p.m. Whether or not he is charged with escape will depend on review of his reason for late return.

37-year old Stephen is serving time for Unauthorized Entry into a Motor Vehicle. His parole was tentatively approved and pending a release date set by the Hawaii Paroling Authority chair.

He is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
