MISSING WORK FURLOUGH INMATE TURNS HIMSELF IN AT OCCC

HONOLULU – Missing OCCC work furlough inmate Ezekiel Gauthier turned himself in today at the facility. Sheriffs arrested him just before 11:30 a.m. at OCCC and are processing him on an additional escape charge. Gauthier failed to return from his furlough pass to Module 20 Monday night.

Gauthier is serving time for Robbery 2. His next parole hearing is scheduled for May of this year.

Gauthier is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
