WCCC EXTENDED FURLOUGH INMATE FAILS TO RETURN TO COMMUNITY-BASED FURLOUGH HOME

HONOLULU – Women's Community Correctional Center (WCCC) extended furlough inmate KalanikalokomaikainuiOrtiz failed to return to the YWCA Fernhurst furlough home in Makiki. She was scheduled to return from her day pass to the residential home at 5:30 p.m. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified by YWCA Fernhurst.

27-year-old Ortiz is 5'6", 130 lbs., and has brown hair and brown eyes.

Ortiz was serving time for Burglary 2 and Theft 2. Escape 2 is expected to be added to her charges. Her next parole hearing is scheduled for September of this year.

The YWCA Fernhurst work furlough program is a community-based, contracted furlough program for female offenders with community custody status.
