MISSING WORK FURLOUGH INMATE VOLUNTARILY RETURNS TO OCCC

HONOLULU – Missing work furlough inmate Vincent Pacheco-Poomaihealani voluntarily turned himself in at the Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) Sunday evening. He was reported missing from the Saturday, 10 p.m. headcount at the Laumaka Work Furlough Center. He was not authorized to leave and now faces an additional escape charge.

Pacheco-Poomaihealani is serving time for Unauthorized Control of a Propelled Vehicle, Promoting a Dangerous Drug 3, Unlawful Use of Drug Paraphernalia and Unauthorized Possession of Confidential Personal Information. His next parole hearing is scheduled for June 2020.

Pacheco-Poomaihealani is a community custody inmate in the work furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
