## OAHU COMMUNITY CORRECTIONAL CENTER FURLOUGH INMATE APOLLO THOMPSON FAILED TO RETURN

Work furlough inmate Apollo Thompson failed to return to OCCC Laumaka housing unit tonight. He was supposed to return by 9:30 pm. Sheriffs and HPD were notified.

Thompson is 50 years old, 6' tall, and 185 lbs. He has black hair and brown eyes.

Thompson is serving time for Forgery 2<sup>nd</sup> and Theft 2<sup>nd</sup>. His minimum sentence will expire on 7-19-2021. He now faces an additional escape charge when found.

He is a community custody inmate in the furlough program with pass privileges. Community custody is the lowest classification status.
