SHERIFFS AND HONOLULU POLICE LOOK FOR RECENTLY RELEASED OCCC PRETRIAL DETAINEE

HONOLULU – On August 10, inmate Christopher Campos was released from the Oahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC). It was later determined that Campos should not have been released. State Sheriffs and Honolulu Police were notified. The Department of Public Safety is conducting an investigation into circumstances surrounding the release.

Campos was in custody for probation revocation related to credit card fraud.

The 65-year-old Campos is 5'10" tall and weighs ???? lbs. He has black hair and brown eyes.
