- a. 340B Prime Vendor Program (PVP): Managed by Apexus under an agreement with the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), the 340B Prime Vendor Program supports participants in several key ways:
 1. Negotiating Discounts: Secures pharmaceutical prices below the standard 340B discount.
 2. Improving Access: Develops distribution networks and solutions to enhance access to affordable medications.
 3. Education: Offers training and resources through programs like 340B University.
 4. Additional Services: Provides value-added products and services to covered entities.

- .1 The purpose of the Prime Vendor Program (PVP) is to improve access to affordable medications for covered entities and their patients.

5.0 PROCEDURES

- .1 Enrollment in the Prime Vendor Program (PVP):
- The Health Care Division registers online for the 340B Program with HRSA.
 - The Health Care Division completes online PVP registration (<https://www.340bpvp.com/register/apply-to-participate-for-340b/>).
 - PVP staff reviews and validates the submitted information, then sends a confirmation email to the Health Care Division.
 - The Division logs on to www.340bpvp.com, creates a username, and sets a password to access PVP services.
- .2 Updating the PVP Profile:
- Visit www.340bpvp.com.
 - Click **Login** in the upper-right corner.
 - Enter PVP login credentials.
 - In the upper right corner click **My Profile** to access the profile page. For detailed instructions, refer to <https://members.340bpvp.com/webMemberProfileInstructions.aspx>.
 - Click **Continue to My Profile** to access the profile page at <https://members.340bpvp.com/webMemberProfile.aspx>.
 - Locate the facilities list and click on the 340B ID number hyperlink to view or update profile information for that facility.
 - Update HRSA Information: Completes the 340B Change Form as outlined. Once 340B OPAIS is updated, the PVP database synchronizes the changes during the nightly update process.
